Born in 1984, Jenny was a wonderful girl, full of possibilities and energy. She had an adventurous spirit and a heart full of deep longings. Purpose:

Completed applications are to be returned to Doug and Glenda Campbell by April 15th of the current year.

Selection Committee:

The Campbells will submit all applications to the Faith Baptist Church (FBC) Selection Committee by April 30th of the current year. The Selection Committee will consist of the FBC pastors and at least one youth leader. The Selection Committee will review the applications and select the student by May 31st of the current year. Preference shall be given to a student who has demonstrated Christian character, involvement in FBC ministry, and who has financial need.
