Week One - Humility - The Speck and the Plank - Matt. 7:1-5 - April 7

- 1. What does it mean to *judge*? Is judgement right or wrong? Matt. 7:1, James 4:11, Luke 6:37, 1 Cor. 5:12; 6:2, John 7:24
- 2. How do people tend to respond to judgement? Consider the reciprocal nature of judgement. Matt. 7:2, Mark 4:24; 6:14,
- 3. What are some potential *planks* that skew our view of others? Matt. 7:3-5; 15:14; 23:24, John 9:39

Week Two - Forgiveness - The Unforgiving Servant - Matt. 18:23-35 - April 14

- 1. How have you found forgiveness to be difficult? Why would we forgive? Matt. 18:23-27, Luke 7:41-43
- 2. What message does our practice of forgiveness convey to the community? Matt. 18:28-31, Col 3:12-17
- 3. Where does our motivation to forgive come from? Matt. 18:32-33, Eph. 4:32

Week Three - Grace - The Workers in the Vineyard - Matt. 20:1-16 - April 21

- 1. Why do you think the Master is continually searching for those he can *hire*? What does this tell us about God's grace-filled heart for people? Matt. 20:1-7
- 2. In Jesus' parable, the Master hired workers for his vineyard. What does that mean for us? What is God calling us to? Matt. 9:37-38, 1 Cor. 3:6-9
- 3. Shouldn't the workers have been paid according to their work? Is this fair? How does this story illustrate grace? Matt. 20:8-16, Eph. 2:8-9

Week Four - Love - The rich man and Lazarus - Luke 16:19-31 - April 28

- 1. What is the relationship between the rich man and Lazarus? (Luke 16:19-21) Did they know each other? Luke 16:24
- 2. Does God care for the poor and marginalized? How should we treat those in need around us? Matt. 22:39, James 1:27; 2:8, Lev. 19:18, Psalm 146:9
- 3. How does this story help us understand God's blessing and comfort? Luke 16:25
- 4. How can we learn from the warning the rich man desperately wanted sent to his brothers? Luke 16:27-31

Week Five - Readiness - Ten Virgins - Matt. 25:1-13 - May 5

- 1. Who do the Bridegroom and virgins represent? Matt. 25:1, Jer. 2:2, 2 Cor 11:2-3, Eph. 5:25-33
- 2. What does the Bridegroom's delay tell us about Jesus 'return? Matt. 25:5-6,
- 3. The foolish virgins missed the moment in their rush to buy oil. (Matt. 25:7-13) Is the last-minute strategy of *making things right with God* a good approach? (Titus 2:11-14) Will the faith of the community (five wise virgins) be enough to save those without a personal faith (five foolish virgins)? Why or why not? John 3:16, James 2:14

Week Six- Stewardship - The Ten Talents - Matthew 25:14-30 - May 12

- 1. In Jesus 'story, each servant is entrusted with a different amount. (Matt. 25:14-15) What responsibilities has Jesus entrusted His followers with? Eph. 4:11-13
- 2. How did the servants make use of what their Master had entrusted them with? (Matt. 25:16-18) How are you using the gifts, responsibilities, and opportunities that God has granted you? 2 Tim. 1:8-14

3. How did the Master respond to each servant upon His return? (Matt. 25:19-30) How does the fearful failing of the third servant call us to act? Does the fear of loss keep you from investing your time, talent, and resources?

Week Seven - Hospitality - The Good Samaritan - Luke 10:29-37 - May 19

- 1. Do you have a long list of people who need your help? Knowing that you can't care for everyone, who do you prioritize? Luke 10:29-33, Matt. 5:43-47; 19:19, 1 John 4:19-21
- 2. What did the Good Samaritan sacrifice to care for the man in need? (Luke 10:34-35) What causes you to hesitate in sharing what you have with those you meet?
- 3. What would motivate us to overlook our differences and care for our fellow man? Luke 10:33.36-37

Week Eight - Testimony - Parable of the Lamp - Matt. 5:13-16 - May 26

- 1. Consider the function of salt and light. How does salt affect taste and light affect sight? Matt. 5:13-15, Mark 4:21-23, Luke 8:16; 11:33-36; 14:34-35
- 2. What does Jesus mean by calling His followers the *Light of the World*? (Matt. 5:14) Isn't Jesus the *Light of the World*? (John 8:12; 9:5) How then can we be *Light in the World*? John 12:36, Phil. 2:15
- 3. Knowing that the world is in darkness, what would cause us to want to hide our light? (Matt. 5:14-16) How can we let our light shine today?
